



Capitol View is a PBIS (Positive Behavioral Interventions & Supports) school. We have 3 expectations that we follow every day. At Capitol View, we're safe, respectful, and responsible. Your students earn tiger tickets when they follow these expectations. Ask your student how many tiger tickets they have earned.

Social Skills Lesson at Capitol View

Teachers are teaching students a social skill every week. We have completed 3 social skills so far this year. The social skills we have taught are:

- To learn and practice how to find alternatives to aggression/fighting.
- To learn and practice how to avoid getting into trouble.
- To learn and practice how to follow directions.

Review these skills with your child at home and help them practice at home and in the community. Students may earn Tiger Tickets if they are following directions at school.
